

Preschool Parent Tips

Please remember to check the student folder daily. Please try to send in Show & Tell; Bookmobile books and other items as requested on time. When they don't have their things there are some very sad preschool faces. Thank you for your help!

Please keep backpacks free of items the students don't need for school. Clutter makes the backpack heavier on the preschoolers back. It is also harder for the preschooler to get things in and out of their backpack.

When your preschooler is using a scissors at home please encourage proper technique. The thumb should be in the small opening of the handle and the first three fingers in the larger oval opening of the handle. If the fourth finger fits in that opening it is ok for the child to hold it that way. When opening and shutting the scissors the thumb should be pointed up. Old magazines and catalogs are great for practicing cutting.
